



WINTER ASSIGNMENT WORK FOR CLASS - LKG Session 2025-26

Dear parents and little stars of LKG!

As the days get cooler and the students enter their winter holidays, it's the perfect time to snuggle up and learn in a fun, relaxed way! This Winter Assignment is designed to keep the learning momentum going while you enjoy the festive season together.

This assignment is a guide, not a burden. Its main goal is to promote meaningful interaction between you and your child, and to help them practice skills in a familiar, comfortable environment. Focus on quality time and positive reinforcement rather than rushing through the tasks. Learning should always be an enjoyable experience!

On daily basis, engage in:

- **Picture Power Reading**
Spend 15-20 minutes daily reading picture books together. Ask your child to point to and name objects, colours, and characters in the pictures. This is aimed at visual vocabulary.
 - **The Please & Thank You Game**
Consistently model and prompt the use of 'Please,' 'Thank You,' and 'Excuse Me'
 - **Rainbow Plate Challenge**
Encourage your child to try at least one fruit or vegetable of a different color each day (e.g., red tomato, green spinach, orange carrot). Talk about why these foods are good for their body.
 - **Helper in the Kitchen**
Let your child help with simple, safe meal prep (like washing vegetables or setting up the table or even serving water).
 - **Mindful Munching**
Practice eating meals at the dining table without distractions (no mobile phones or TV). This teaches them to focus on their food and listen to their body's hunger cues.

- Identification and recognition of upper and lower case letter A-Z with phonic sound and words (RECAPITULATION)
- Writing Practice of small case cursive letters
